

The Lord continues to do great and mighty things in the nation of Honduras! In just one month we did more than forty outreaches in many different cities and villages throughout Honduras. We have seen many children, youth, and adults dedicate their lives to Jesus. All the hours traveling in the car, sleeping on the floor, the mosquito bites, and the ice cold showers are definitely worth it.

This year Love Honduras is officially starting a new ministry. When we are not in the mountains or in the rainforest, we go into downtown Tegucigalpa to preach the Gospel and give out food. My husband, Josue,

and I have been put in charge of this ministry and we could not be more excited! We have met people from many backgrounds during our downtown ministry including people who are broken, addicts, prostitutes, immigrants from all over Central America trying to get to the USA, gang members as young as eight years old, and other children who are roaming the dangerous streets of Tegucigalpa all by themselves. We have seen mothers with their children sleeping on the streets. When we go downtown to an area called Los Dolores, we are bringing the light of Jesus into a very dark and sad place. Other churches and ministries









do not want to work downtown because it's too dangerous for them. In reality the people are not dangerous, they just need someone to love them. The first time we went and preached the Gospel to the line of people waiting for the food we were giving away, at least ten people raised their hands wanting to receive Jesus in their hearts. We invited everyone to a very good local church that we also attend. We are so excited to see this ministry take off and grow! Our goal is get every adult and child off the streets in Los Dolores and see their lives get on track for Jesus.

I feel repetitive when I say this, but God continues to open more doors in Honduras and Central America. I am sure you all know by now about Montaña de la Flor. Allmost all the feeding programs that Love Honduras operates are located on that mountain. An awesome ministry in Guatemala that I had the privilege of working with when I lived there, recently started donating picnic tables and bunk beds to families in Montaña de la Flor. Families who were sleeping on the floor, are now sleeping in a comfortable bed. We just gave one bunk bed away to a family that was literally sleeping on tree branches. It's beautiful to see men and women of God work together for His Kingdom! The beds and tables are another tool we can use to share the Gospel with these people. Many times sharing the love of Jesus is more powerful through action than through a sermon.

Josue and I are working as full-time missionaries. The reason we send this newsletter to you is to keep you informed about everything we are doing. We can continue what God has called us to do because of your support. We want to thank all our partners who have been such a blessing to us personally and to the Kingdom of God. Thank you for your prayers and financial support! You can also give directly to Love Honduras ministries to support all the feeding programs in Montaña de La Flor. It is only \$5 a month to feed a child at risk of hunger four times a week. God bless you!
